



AAR (After Action Review)

AAR (After Action Review) is a method of capturing and sharing practical knowledge from the field used by the U.S. Army. The core of the method is that after hostilities, a commanding officer prepares a report evaluating the action (After Action Review).

Transposed into the environment of the organization, after completing the task or project, the leader of the task, project manager and all key team members should prepare a short report on the essential characteristics of all completed activities and highlight everything new, what they learn within the task. Reports are preferably stored in an electronic information system (intranet, wiki, etc.) to make them available to all employees of the organization for which they are relevant.
