This has many benefits which include loss of tooth coating being removed compared to porcelain veneers, costing less than porcelain veneers, requiring fewer visits to the dentist, and being easily fixed when damaged. Here are the steps to applying composite resin veneers After preparing and shaping the teeth, the dentist will bond and sculpt the composite material in a color that best matches the rest of the teeth.

A curing light is used to harden the composite and make it bond to the teeth.

The composite resin veneer is polished and smoothed to make it look like natural teeth.

3. Considerations for Dental Veneers

Having healthy teeth and gums is important. Any decay or disease will have to be treated before the installation of veneers. Veneers are not recommended to those who clench or grind their teeth. Thin veneers can chip or break, and the dentist might require wearing a dental night guard during sleep.
