What is ligation and stripping surgery?

Vein ligation and vein stripping is a surgical procedure in which your doctor will remove your enlarged, twisted, and damaged varicose veins that developed due to hormonal change, genetics, and many other issues. After removal of varicose veins, there will be a development of new veins for allowing blood flow in the legs.

How long does the procedure last?

The procedure of vein stripping and ligation typically takes 2 hours to 3 hours. The procedure is performed in an outpatient setting where you can simply visit your home for some intervals after the treatment.



Should you treat varicose veins early?

When should they visit a vein specialist but the answer is if you haven't faced serious symptoms of varicose veins such as severe pain in standing, skin discoloration, and dry patches. Then it is not essential to visit a vein specialist for surgical procedures. But if you are experiencing small varicose veins that don't cause pain and discomfort then you can treat them at home by exercising.

How painful is varicose vein stripping?

We have found from studies, the removal of varicose veins from vein stripping causes little pain while the incision doctor performs. In many cases, people experience soreness in the legs for 1 to 2 weeks. Your doctor will provide you antibiotics for solving the condition and some medication for disappearing the bruises.

Who is not the right candidate for vein stripping?

Not everyone can survive the surgical procedure of vein stripping. We have mentioned some signs that show you are not the right candidate for vein stripping such as:

- » Pregnant women are not a candidate for vein stripping and ligation
- » Aged people suffering from further serious medical issues.
- » Suffering from improper blood circulation in legs
- » Facing severe swelling in the leg
- » Suffering from arteriovenous fistula in the leg.

How long is recovery from vein stripping?

The recovery time of vein stripping and ligation generally takes 2 to 4 weeks. Hence we have found from studies that the recovery time may vary depending on the number of veins that were stripped during the procedure. For two to four weeks a patient may feel little pain and discomfort.
